This service provides vaccination for 0 - 59 months old of Midsayap and nearby municipalities. Vaccination gives protection against immunizable diseases. The following are the vaccines that are given to babies: BCG, Hepatitis B Vaccine, OPV, Pentavalent, PCV, Measles, RotaVirus and IPV.
